



Top or Bottom of Duvet Protector



Putting On Your Duvet Protector & Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the duvet protector. This protector will help protect either the top, or bottom, of your duvet. You need to decide which side of the duvet you want to protect.

Your duvet goes inside the protector. One side of the protector is a space age polyester membrane that is both waterproof and breathable. The other side is a super fine mesh.

Putting on and taking off the protector is fast and easy. Your protector (with your duvet inside) needs to be inserted into a decorative duvet cover.

Step 1:

Remove the protector from the plastic bag. Your duvet, or comforter, will go inside the protector. Open the zipper at the end of the protector.

You'll find cloth ties **inside** the protector at each corner – there are a total of four inside ties. You will use these ties inside the protector to secure your duvet to the protector.

Place your duvet inside the protector.

Tie the corners of the duvet to the inside cloth protector ties. This will stop the duvet from shifting inside the protector. Close the protector zipper.

Step 2:

There are cloth ties on the **outside** of the protector at each corner – there are a total of four outside ties.

Place the protector (with the duvet inside) inside your decorative duvet cover.

Tie the four cloth ties on the **outside** of the protector to your decorative duvet cover. This will keep the protector from shifting within the duvet cover.

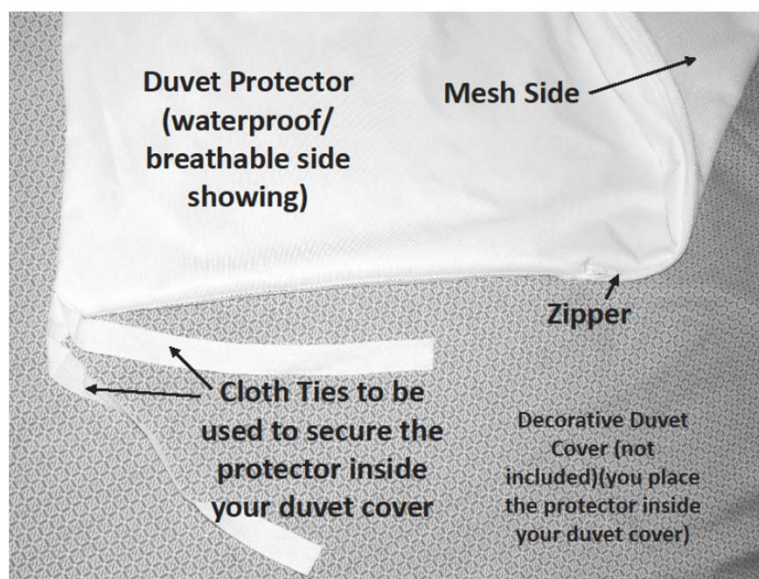
Step 3:

Position your decorative cover (with the protector and duvet inside) on your bed.

If you want to protect the top of your duvet (for example, to protect your duvet from a pet on top of your duvet) make sure the solid white solid side of the protector is on **top** (and the mesh side is on the bottom).

Likewise, if you want to protect the bottom of your duvet (for example, to protect your duvet from a bed wetting child) make sure the white solid side is on the bottom (and the mesh side is on the top).

Liquids can enter the protector through the mesh. It is important to ensure the duvet and the protector do not shift within your decorative duvet cover - so your duvet is protected.

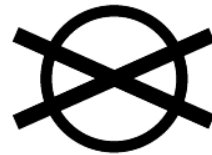

Washing Instructions:

Your Top or Bottom of Duvet Protector is fast and easy to machine wash and dry.

- Wash and dry separately from other items.
- Wash the protector with cold, or warm, water on a delicate setting using a **mild liquid** laundry detergent.
- Do not use bleach or fabric softeners as these may damage the waterproof breathable membrane.
- Because the protector fabric is waterproof you may need to manually drain any water captured within the protector before spin drying.
- Tumble machine dry on a cool setting.
- Do not dry clean as these will damage the fabric.

In the event of an 'accident' remove the duvet immediately from the cover and protector. We recommend using an enzyme based urine treatment directly on the accident on the protector. Follow the directions on the urine treatment product.
