



Top of Duvet Waterproof Breathable Duvet Protector



Putting on Your Duvet Protector & Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the duvet protector. The protector will help protect your duvet or comforter for many years to come.

Putting on and taking off the protector is quick and easy.

The protector protects the top of your duvet by attaching to the top of the duvet.

Your duvet with the protector attached needs to be inserted into a decorative duvet cover.

The protector uses a space age polyester membrane that is both waterproof and breathable.

There are several things that will ensure your duvet is protected, you have a great night's sleep, and are able to easily wash your protector.

Step 1:

Spread out your duvet.

Remove the protector from the plastic bag.

Place the protector on top of your duvet so the protector is evenly distributed on all sides on top of your duvet.

The protector attaches to the top of your duvet using i) adjustable clips, and ii) cloth ties.

Step 2 – Attaching the Metal Clips:

You are going to open up the metal clips and attach them to the edge of your duvet. (Photos are shown on the next page.)

First, if needed, adjust the white straps using the adjustment buckle so the metal clip sits at the edge of your duvet.

Open the metal clip by pulling up the shiny metal top of the clip. The plastic teeth within the metal clip will open when you open the clip.

Place the edge of the duvet into the plastic teeth. Close the clip by pushing down on the clip's metal top. Make sure the edge of the duvet is still in the clip teeth.


Do this for each of the adjustable straps attached to the protector.

Step 3 – Cloth Ties:

You can also use the cloth ties to help secure the protector to the top of your duvet,.


Wrap the cloth ties around the corner of the duvet. Using a knot or bow, attach the ties to the duvet.

You can also use these ties to help attach your decorative duvet cover to your duvet. If you do this, you need to tie the protector to the duvet – and then tie to the decorative cover (this is so the protector stays in place on you duvet).


Open the metal clip by pulling up the shiny metal top of the clip. The plastic teeth within the metal clip will open when you open the clip.



Place the edge of the duvet into the plastic teeth.




Close the clip with the edge of the duvet still in the teeth by pushing down on the clip's metal top.



Once the metal clips are attached it will look like this in this photo.

Washing Instructions:

Before you wash your protector you need to remove the metal clips.



Your Top of Bed Waterproof Breathable Duvet Protector is fast and easy to machine wash and dry.

- Wash and dry separately from other items.
- Wash the protector with cold, or warm, water on a delicate setting using a **mild liquid** laundry detergent.
- Do not use bleach or fabric softeners as these may damage the waterproof breathable membrane.
- Because the protector fabric is waterproof you may need to manually drain any water captured within the protector before spin drying.
- Tumble machine dry on a cool setting.
- Do not dry clean as these will damage the fabric.

In the event of an 'accident' remove the duvet immediately from the cover and liner. We recommend using an enzyme based urine treatment directly on the accident. Follow the directions on the urine treatment product.
