

Microfiber Door Protectors



Installation and Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the Microfiber Door Protectors. Your new protectors will help keep the inside of your doors free from scratches, water, dirt and mud for years to come.

Your protectors are fast and easy to install.

Two protectors come in a set. One side of each protector is tan "A". The other side of each protector is grey "B". You can chose to have tan colored protectors on both the right and left hand doors, or you can have grey protectors on both doors.

Step 1:


Remove both door protectors from the package. Decide which protector color best matches your vehicle interior.


Step 2:

Hold up one of the protectors to the inside panel of the door where you want the protector to go. The edge of the protector with the plastic tabs "C" should be facing up near the window. Make certain that the protector is oriented correctly with the long side of the protector "D" closest to the door hinge. If the short side of the protector "E" is closest to the door hinges then you need to switch that protector with the other protector in the set.

Step 3:

Window Sensors: Some vehicle models have window sensors that detect if there is something stopping or slowing down the window from closing. This sensor is intended to stop arms, fingers and dogs from getting pinched when the electric window closes. On some vehicle models, the door sensor may detect the door protector once it is installed. If this is the case, check your owner's manual to find out how to close your windows if the protectors are detected.


Step 3 Continued...:

... panel by the three plastic tabs "C". These three plastic tabs go inside the vehicle in between the window glass "i" and the plastic weather stripping "ii".

With the window up, use the edge of the plastic tab "iii" to separate the plastic weather stripping from the window glass to slip the tab in. Do this for all three tabs.

Step 4:

Move the tabs across the window so the door protector is evenly spread across the door panel. Push the tabs as far down as they will go between the glass and the weather stripping. Note that you may have to slide the tab over slightly if you encounter resistance pushing down the plastic tab.



Washing Instructions:

The Microfiber Door Protectors are fast and easy to clean.

Wash and dry separately from other items. Machine wash the protectors using cold water on a gentle setting using a mild laundry detergent, such as Woolite. Tumble machine dry on a cool to warm setting. Do not use bleach, and do not dry clean as these will damage the upholstery grade microfiber fabric. After removing from the vehicle, the protectors can also be hosed off using a garden hose. Either hang the protectors to dry, or tumble machine dry on a cool to warm setting.
