



Waterproof Cotton Duvet Cover (Waterproof On One Side)



Using Your Duvet Cover & Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the Waterproof Cotton Duvet Cover. The cover will protect your duvet for many years to come.

The cover is made from 100% cotton with a space age polyester membrane that is both waterproof and breathable.

Using the cover, and washing the cover, is quick and easy.

Step 1:

Remove the cover from the plastic bag. The cover is both a protector and a decorative cover. Once you place your duvet (or comforter) inside the cover, no other cover is needed. We made the cover so you'll only need this cover for your duvet.

Step 2:

Open the zipper on the cover. Work your duvet inside the cover. Find the cotton ties inside the cover (the ties are attached to each corner inside the duvet cover). Tie the cotton ties to the corners of the duvet. This will stop the duvet from shifting within the cover. Close the zipper on the cover.

Step 3:

One side of the duvet cover is waterproof. The other side is 100% cotton with no waterproof breathable layer.

Locate the waterproof side of the cover from the label sewn onto the cover. The waterproof layer side will say "This Side Waterproof".

If you want the waterproof layer to protect the top of your duvet (for example, to protect your duvet from dogs or kids on top of your bed) position the waterproof side facing up. Continued...

If you want the waterproof layer to protect the side of your duvet where someone sleeps, place the waterproof side facing down.

Washing Instructions:

Your Waterproof Duvet Cover is fast and easy to clean.

- Wash and dry separately from other items.
- Wash the cover with cold water on a delicate setting using a mild laundry detergent, such as Woolite®.
- Do not use bleach or fabric softeners as these may damage the waterproof/breathable membrane.
- Because one side of the cover fabric is waterproof you may need to manually drain any water captured within the cover before spin drying.
- Tumble machine dry on a cool setting.
- Do not iron the waterproof side of the cover.
- Do not dry clean as these will damage the fabric.

In the event of an 'urine accident' remove the duvet immediately from the cover and cover. We recommend using an enzyme based urine treatment directly on the accident. Follow the directions on the urine treatment product.
