



Waxed Cotton Canvas Pet Hammock



Installation and Cleaning

Thank you for purchasing the Waxed Cotton Canvas Pet Hammock. Your four legged best friends will enjoy the hammock, and your vehicle and backseat will remain clean and protected for years to come.

Installing, and removing, the hammock is quick and easy.

The hammock installs over the backseat of your vehicle and requires front and back seat head restraint posts to install.

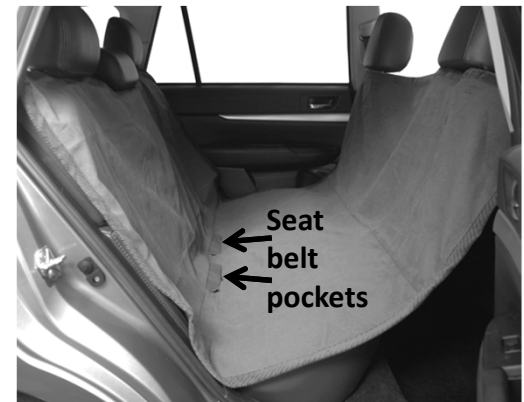
Our hammock uses legendary waxed cotton canvas fabric detailed with corduroy trimming. The result is highly functional pet hammock with a distinctive traditional design.

The hammock gains character with age.

Step 1:

Remove the hammock from the plastic bag.

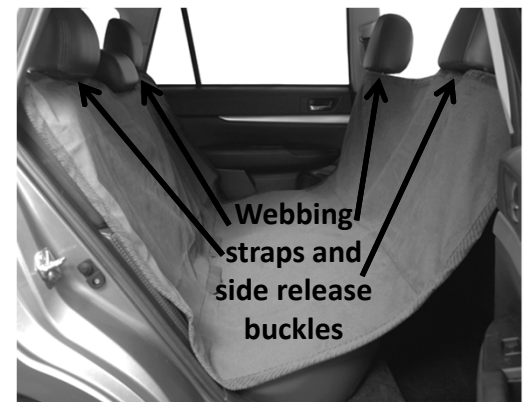
Position the hammock on the back seat so the waxed cotton canvas side is facing up (note the bottom of the hammock is plaid cotton) and the seat belt pockets are positioned to allow the seat belts to pass through the hammock.



Step 2:

Locate the four webbing straps and side release buckles that are on the top edge of the hammock. Undo the side release buckles (by squeezing the buckles) attached to all four webbing straps. Loop the webbing around the driver's and front passenger seat head restraint posts. You may need to raise the head restraints to get to the posts underneath. Reattach the two ends of the side release buckles.

Loop the webbing straps around the back seat passenger head restraint posts. Reattach the side release buckles.



Step 3:

The top of the hammock may hang too far down from the head restraint posts. If this is the case, adjust the webbing straps through the side release buckles to your desired hammock height.

Step 4:

Loosening, or tightening, the webbing straps also adjusts the height of the hammock between the two front bucket seats. Some people prefer to keep the hammock relatively tight between the two front seats to create a more substantial barrier between the front and back seats.

Step 5:

The Hammock has openings that allow seat belts to be passed through the Hammock (an extra piece of fabric connected to the seat belt openings ensures that sand and dirt doesn't go through the Hammock into the backseat).



Cleaning Instructions:

With proper care your Waxed Cotton Canvas Pet Hammock will last a long time and will keep its classic styling and functionality. It is natural for the hammock to gain character with use and time.

Hose off, or sponge wipe, with cold water only. Hang to dry.

If dirt is ground in, brush off the dirt with a soft bristled brush, and then rinse with cold water.

Hang to dry.

Do not use soap, detergent, solvents, or bleach as these will remove the natural wax waterproof coating.

Do not iron. Do not wring to dry.
